Dr Gina Johnson: Clinical Skills

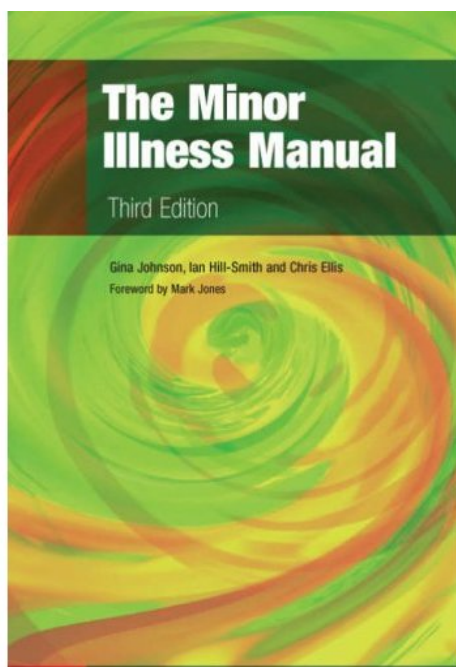
