The total cost depends on the number of students and associated expenses. As a guide, our 5-day Minor Illness Specialist Seminar Week is currently offered at £900 per delegate, which leads on to the option of formal assessment and the RCN accredited N^{mic} Diploma at £650 per delegate. The Paediatric one-day courses cost around £5,000 for up to 24 students. These prices include venue, catering costs, and all course materials.
